Vodka

The word vodka comes from the Slavic voda meaning 'water', and vodka contains ethanol and water. It is typically colourless and flavourless and when first sold on the United States it was marketed as white whisky. Vodka originated In Poland in the 1400's.

Smirnoff Red £2.90

Three distillations and ten stages of filtration to deliver smoothness and clarity. Exceptionally smooth.

Absolut Blue £2.90

Absolut Vodka is a classic tasting vodka distilled from winter wheat. The recipe is over 30 years old and the bottle design is based on an 18th century medicine flask.

Stoli Vanilla Vodka £3.20

Starting with the finest spirits, distilled from wheat and clear glacial water, it is then married to the extracts of Madagascan and Indonesian vanilla beans to achieve it's distinctive taste.

Stoli Razberi Vodka £3.20

Blackwoods Nordic Vodka £3.20

Blackwoods Botanical Vodka is distilled five times before it is infused with botanicals using bonification to give it a refined flavour profile. The four botanicals used are meadow sweet, sea pink, angelica and marsh marigold, which Blackwoods also use in their gins.

Rum

Rum, known as ron in Spanish, is made from the fermentation and distillation of the molasses from sugarcane, which are them aged in oak casks. Most rum comes from the Caribbean and the parts of South America along the banks of the Demarara.

Bacardi Superior £2.90

The nose is light and fresh with a little spice and pepper, quite spirity. The palate is of medium-body with hints of tropical fruit and a note of dark brown sugar and winter spice. The finish is good with smooth vanilla spice notes.

Morgans Spiced Rum £2.90

Smooth and medium bodied, Captain Morgan's Spiced is a spirit drink based on a secret blend of premium Caribbean rums, mellow spice and other natural flavours. It gets its distinct richness and amber colour from ageing the rum in charred white oak barrels.

OVD Rum £2.90

A dark Demerara rum from Guyana. This was aged in oak casks and has a sweet, creamy flavour.

Sailor Jerry Rum £3.60

The nose has good sweetness with notes of vanilla spice, butter, oak, cinnamon, nutmeg and ground ginger. The palate is dry and sweet with notes of winter spice and black pepper, toffee. The finish is long and crisp with oak and spice.

Havana 3yr old £3.90

The nose is crisp and fresh with notes of marzipan, citrus, allspice, ground ginger, a little lime and gentle oak. The palate is clean and rounded with notes of citrus, vanilla and oak, a little spice and lemon and a delicate nutty note.

Havana 7yr old £4.50

The nose is sweet and buttery with notes of toffee and coffee, a little spice and dried peels with notes of orchard fruits and biscuits. The palate is full and rich with notes of cigar box, notes of orchard fruits and toffee hints.

Cognac & Armagnac

The grapes grown on the champagne limestone around the town of Cognac are the best in the world, and once they have been pot distilled and aged for at least two years they are allowed to be called Cognac. It is the most exclusive type of brandy and can be barrel-aged for up to 100 years.

Martell VS £3.75

One of the most recognisable brands in the world, this is the foundation of Martell's enormous international success. Prepared using eaux-de-vie aged for two years on average, Martell VS is a bright young, fresh, fruity cognac.

Martell VSOP £5.25

Darker and more complex than the VS, this is a great after-dinner Cognac. Rich, smooth and mellow.

Courvoisier VS £3.95

A mouth-watering blend, elegant and harmonious with fresh fruit flavours enhanced with toasty oak hints.

Courvoisier VSOP £5.50

Discerning, elegant and complex, VSOP Fine Cognac develops exceptional aromas of jasmine, peach and toasted almond. This cognac intricately crafted is exquisitely balanced.

Remy Martin VSOP £5.95

Remy Martin is the benchmark for the VSOP category and is blended from spirits aged from 4 to 12 years. This latest version finishes the cognac in old barrels for a year before bottling.

<u>Sherry</u>

Sherry is actually one of the world's oldest wines and has a long history in the area known as the sherry triangle in the South of Spain which is marked by Jerez de la Frontera, Sanlúcar de Barrameda, and El Puerto de Santa María in the region of Cádiz. Over the centuries, the drink has been influenced and helped by a number of different civilizations and cultures from the Phoenicians to the British.

Alegria Manzanilla Dry Sherry £3.50

Wonderfully aromatic, pale and vibrant manzanilla which is light in texture but intense in flavour. Dry, and refreshing with a lovely salty tang so typical of high-quality manzanilla.

Dry Sack Medium Dry Sherry £3.50

Medium-dry six year-old blend of Palomino and Pedro Ximenez grapes. It is made using the solera method and the brand is a century old. Dry Sack offers flavours of dried fruit and nuts.

Walnut Brown Sweet Sherry £3.50

Very sweet Oloroso. Dark mahogany, almost ebony. On the nose, dried nuts and faint aroma of raisins, muscatel and toasted sugar. Smooth and velvety with a warm palate owing to its alcohol content.

<u> Liqueurs & Exotics</u>

Liqueurs are sweet alcoholic beverages, and the word liqueur comes from the Latin work liquifacere which means 'to dissolve'. Liqueurs are low in alcohol content compared to spirits as they have high sugar content.

Amaretto £3.50

Amaretto is a liqueur with an almond flavour enhanced with apricot hints and lots of exotic herbs and spices. Amaretto is Italian for 'a little bitter'.

Archers Peach Schnapps

£3.20

A fresh, fruity, peach flavoured, mouth-watering schnapps.

Baileys £3.90

The whisky complements the full, richness of the fresh Irish dairy cream, cocoa and heavenly vanilla that all go into this truly delicious moreish liqueur. True to its roots, every bottle of Baileys is produced and bottled exclusively in Ireland.

Chambord £3.20

The finest black and red raspberries are blended, before being steeped in Cognac to achieve a highly concentrated base which is infusion with Madagascan vanilla, Moroccan citrus peel, honey and herbs.

Cointreau £3.50

This classic orange liqueur has been a world wide legend since its creation in 1849. Moreish with luscious sweet orange flavours enhanced with hints of lemon.

Drambuie £3.80

Drambuie Whisky Liqueur has a honeyed, rich sweetness which masks any bite from the whisky, leaving it smooth and warming with a heathery complexity.

Glayva £3.80

Hugely popular Scottish liqueur made with whisky, honey, spices, almonds and tangerines. Rather brilliantly, Glayva is now trademarked as the "best liqueur in the world" after winning the IWSC trophy a record breaking five times.

Grand Marnier £3.80

A soft nose of orange with a sweet chocolate aroma slowly arriving. Rich on the palate although very refreshing with a long, sweet offering.

Kahlua £3.50

Quality rum-based coffee liqueur from Mexico. Also contains corn syrup and vanilla bean.

Malibu £3.20

Delicate and slightly sweeter than other rums, Malibu's fresh taste with distinct coconut flavour makes it exotically refreshing in a variety of ways. For a tropical twist, try it long over ice with pineapple or orange juice. Or enjoy it short with cola or your favourite mixer.

Midori £3.50

Midori is a premium liqueur with the refreshing taste of natural melon that's easy to mix, easy to drink.

Pernod £3.50

The nose reveals waves of anise and herbs. In the mouth experience the exotic anise taste and the long, liquorice finish.

Sambuca £3.50

A complex palate with huge notes of liquorice, aniseed and pepper with a lingering peppery finish. Rich and well balanced.

Southern Comfort £3.20

A very popular liqueur first made in 1874. Southern Comfort is made with whiskey, peaches, herbs and spices.

Tequila Jose Cuervo

£3.60

Creamy palate with mixed spices, toasted oak and herbs with a slightly oaky, spicy finish.

Tia Maria £3.50

Tia Maria is a Jamaican coffee liqueur made with Jamaican Blue Mountain beans. It is flavoured with vanilla and sugar.

Vermouths and Aperitifs

Vermouth - In the past, wines had alcohol added as a Preservative and the most popular additive was brandy. Modern bottling methods mean that wine can survive without fortification, but a demand for these sweet wines still remains.

Aperitifs - The word aperitif comes from the Latin aperio, which means 'to open' or 'to lay bare'. Aperitifs are flavoured with herbs, spices, fruits and roots of many different plants, and have the perceived effect of increasing hunger so are commonly taken before a meal.

Martini Dry £2.90

This best seller includes the usual Martini white wine base and herbal ingredients but with a much reduced level of additional sugar for a dry, but not bitter vermouth.

Martini Rosso £2.90

A great all-rounder, medium bodied sweet red vermouth with lovely herby hints.

Martini Bianco £2.90

Classic, aromatic, medium dry vermoth from Turin, made by macerating Alpine herbs and vanilla with white wine, before sweetening and fortification.

Campari £3.20

An Italian liqueur aperitif created in the 19th century in a coffee shop in Milan by Gaspare Campari. Flavoured with an array of 68 herbs and spices.

Pimm's £3.20

The classic British summer drink. A gin based aperitif with lots of fruity fresh flavours.

Good body with lots of fruit, citrus, zest and spice on the nose. The palate is packed with exotic fruit and spicy pepper with smoky hints and good length.

Cardhu 12yr old

The nose shows good body, decent sweetness and richness with streaks of smoke, apple peels and pears. The palate is smooth and rounded with gentle sweetness, soft peat and little smoke whispers.

Light golden in colour with cereal notes on the nose. The palate is smooth with fresh apples and a little smoke.

The lightest and most refreshing of the Glenturret malts. Rich golden colour with nutty, toasty aromas. The palate is rich and fruity with well balanced, oak tannins and hints of earthiness.

Glengoyne 10yr old

£5.50

Light malt from the outskirts of Glasgow. Pale straw with gold highlights. A smooth, creamy palate with some nuttiness.

Knockando 12 yr old

£5.00

Pale gold with leafy and toffee notes. The mouth-feel is Wonderfully smooth and complex with balanced dryness.

Macallan Gold

£5.50

Lemon citrus nose with a lingering floral and light oak notes. The palate shows citrus and boiled sweets along with hints of ginger and cinnamon, while soft oak tones reveal toasted apples.

Mortlach Rare Old Malt

£7.95

Baked apple and crushed nuts with leafy notes on the nose. The palate is rich and full with spicy notes of cinnamon sticks and oak. Then there's vanilla, raisin and biscuity notes paired with dark jammy touches.

Oban 14yr old

£4.50

Amber in colour and a hit of the seaside. Flavour begins sweetish and ends dry with some peat smoke which is unusual in a Highland.

Old Pulteney 12yr old

£4.50

The nose is crisp and clean with great balance which reveals notes of fresh herbs. The palate is medium body with nuts, sultana, toffee, spices and oak touches.

Singleton of Dufftown 12yr old

£5.50

Nutty and malty with a fruity edge. Great if you are new to the whisky adventure.

Strathisla 12yr old

£4.50

Soft oak on the nose with hints of candied peel. The palate has a malty core with sultanas and cinnamon touches followed by a long, fruity finish.

Tomatin 12yr old

£5.00

Delicately spicy on the nose, fresh, aniseed and sandalwood aromas. The palate is sweet biscuit with a touch of pistachios.

Tullibardine 10yr old

£5.50

The nose is quite subtle and light. There are notes of apple blossom and oats. The palate is warm with notes of white pepper and cloves. The oak is soft and chewy and develops with a touch of caramel on the finish.

Island Malts

Ardbeg

25ml Glass

Full on peat aromas with this malt. Smooth and smoky with a little medicinal bite.

Bowmore 12yr old

£5.50

Complex and more subtle that the more Southern Islay malts. Smoky and fruity with toffee notes. Beautifully long and deliciously flavoursome.

Bruichladdich 10yr old

£5.75

Rich and creamy with lemon and honey on the nose enhanced with oak touches. The palate is warm and oaky with sultana hints and a long lasting finish.

Bunnahabhain 12yr old

£5.50

Light in colour and in body. Slightly salty with just a whiff of smoke. Delicate enough for the afternoons!

Caol lla 12yr old

Pale gold with a slightly greenish tinge. Quite light with a malty biscuit and heather nose. Good body and a chocolaty, smooth

Highland Park 12yr old

£5.50

Mid gold in colour, delicate balance between sweet & dry followed by a slightly honeyed mouth-feel and that characteristic smoky finish.

Highland Park 18yr old

£13.95

A profusion of ripe floral notes and fresh blossom and honeyed exotic fruits. The palate is creamy and full with full fruit flavours, followed by notes of toffee with thick black forest honey with a touch more citrus.

Highland Park 25yr old

Aromas of cherries and toasted walnuts. The palate shows stewed fruit, vanilla and some peat with a hint of spiciness and a long, flavoursome finish. A fantastic malt with perfect balance.

Highland Park 30yr old

After spending 30 years maturing, this Highland Park single malt Scotch whisky has earned the right to be enjoyed very slowly, to have every sip savoured. An outstanding whisky, rich chocolate and toffee notes with a gently, smoky finish.

Highland Park Dark Origins

£11.95

Vanilla, dates and citrus on the nose with flavours of sweet fruits, nuts and oak. The finish is fruity with sherry hints, chocolate and soft oak.

Isle of Jura 10yr old

Light peat and oil on the nose. Relatively light with hints of sweet citrus and fruit ending on a dry, nutty finish.

Isle of Jura Superstition

£5.75

Firm and positive yet mellow. Rich, sensual notes of honey and marzipan with lots of fruit on the finish.

Lagavulin 12yr old

Saty, smoky, citrus aromas with candied lemon and lime flavours, nutty hints and savoury smoke. The finish is long with wood smoke and fruit.

Laphroaig 10yr old

£5.50

This malt opens on big, smoky peat notes with hints of spice. The palate is creamy with oak and vanilla enhanced with spice and black pepper touches.

Scapa 16yr old

£7.25

Light, un-peated and dry with some floral and herbal notes and just a hint of orange.

Talisker 10yr old

Mid gold with pungent, burnt wood aromas. Full bodied with a spicy, smoky and black pepper finish. Also known as 'the lava of the Cuillins'.

Tobermory 10yr old

£4.50

Light with a touch of nuttiness and toffee. An easy introduction to the island whiskies.

Speyside Malts

Glenlossie 10yr old

£6.50

The nose is full of cereal with notes of malt and wood shavings. The palate has good body with a decent sweetness and plenty of fruit with barley sugar and peppery oak.

Glenrothes 1989

£13.80

In appearance, medium golden and brilliant. Very rich on the nose, with spices, fruits and sultanas. In the mouth, smooth, mature, oaky with dried fruits that ends with a really long semi-sweet finish. A real treat.

Inchgower 14yr old

£6.50

Rich caramel, toffee nose is much more evident with a slight nuttiness developing. The palate is rich and smooth with a light nuttiness. Develops into a drier, spicy and slightly salty taste.

Glenrothes 1990

£13.80

Robust with meaty notes, toffee and honey. A long period of time in ex Bourbon casks tends to impart vanilla, apricot, tangerine and a general juiciness.

Glenrothes 1995

£9.95

Medium golden, clear, bright colour. The bouquet has floral, citrus and butterscotch with hints of peppery spice and wood. The palate is wonderfully rich and fruity with lush spice and soft oak hints.

Glenrothes Select Reserve

£5.50

Oak and vanilla aromas with plummy hints. The palate is fruity with vanilla and orange zest touches with a long, slightly spicy finish.

Tamdhu 10yr old

£6.95

Sherry cask matured and full of sweet, rich and creamy flavours you'd expect from a great malt...

Lowland Malts

Auchentoshan 12yr old (Lowland)

£5.50

Grassy, green and fresh meadow-like. The add water to highlight the cereal notes with a lemony dry finish.

Bladnoch 1987 (Lowland)

£12.95

The nose is aromatic and herbaceous. Cereal notes develop with malty sweet barley, spiciness and notes of dry wood. The palate is sweet with spice and soft oak. Finishes long and smooth.

Deanston 12yr old (Lowland)

£5.50

Mellow, fruity and fragrant with a lingering aftertaste. Pale and unpeated.

Glenkinchie 12yr old Lowland)

£5.00

Almost the colour of white wine. Light, fragrant nose with vanilla and meadows. Slightly sweet start with fresh fruit and ginger on the finish.

Springbank 12yr old (Lowland)

£5.50

Light in colour yet rich in flavour. Citrus, pear and a little peat. Clean yet rich and full on the finish.

Blended Whisky, Other Whisky & Rye

Malt whisky is mainly sold to blenders who mix it with grain whisky to give a consistent flavour. Grain whisky is made from a grain other than barley, such as wheat or maize. Two casks of malt, from the same batch aged for the same period of time, will not always be identical to each other, so a blender will use his skill to make one expression.

Scottish

Famous Grouse £2.90

A much loved favourite. Perfectly balanced with notes of orange citrus, sherry and oak tones.

Bells £2.90

The distinctive taste of Bell's comes from bringing together a select blend of grain and fine malt whiskies, all matured in selected oak casks for a richer flavour.

Black Bottle £3.20

A bottle of the 2013 relaunched Black Bottle. Owners Burn Stewart have decided to return the brand to its original 1879 roots, including the black glass that gave the blend its name. With less of a focus on Islay, there is less peatiness than hitherto, with the smoky flavours being balanced with increased fruitiness and elegance.

Irish

Black Bush £3.50

A rich, dark, Irish blend, Black Bush contains a high proportion of triple-distilled single malt, aged in Oloroso sherry casks for around 8-10 years before marriage with the grain.

Jamesons Irish Whiskey

£3.50

Good body with notes of orchard fruit and vanilla enhanced with spice and subtle honey hints.

<u>American</u>

Jack Daniels £3.50

Light, smooth aromas with plenty of sweetness, hints of spice and oak. The palate is smooth and soft with sweet cereal notes and hints of toasty oak.

Knob Creek £4.50

Knob Creek embodies the look, feel and taste of pre-prohibition bourbon. This is a long-aged, high-rye bourbon.

Jim Beam £3.20

Made to the same formula since 1795, this giant of the category is aged for four years in oak barrels to create a smooth, mellow taste with hints of spice.

Canadian

Canadian Club £3.20

A giant of Canadian whisky, created in 1858 and spending six long years in oak before bottling for the smoothest possible flavour.
